LOOK

Look at the clouds and see what you shapes you can make out of them. Collect one natural item for each letter of the alphabet.

LOVE

Give everyone a hug and say something positive about them. Water the new trees as on the map.

LEARN

Make a friendship bracelet and give it to a friend, ensure the whole group has one. Identify one bird who visits the campsite.

Make funny faces in the mirror.

Do at least 5 tasks

Decorate a biscuit using red, white and blue icing.

On a paper plate make a garden using natural objects.

Do Scouts pace round the edge of the field (20 walk, 20 run).

Walk to Castle Ashby gardens and have a picnic.

Make an edible campfire.

Make up a game based on plants and animals.

Play a scavenger hunt.

Guide Challenge Do at least 6 Tasks

Make up a song or rap about your camp/holiday and perform to the rest of the group.

Cross stitch a badge/bookmark.

Make and decorate a plate-bag.

Perform a camp fire stunt in groups.

Learn how to tie a friendship knot.

Make a Washstand from finding wood and string in the fastest time.

Follow a trail of clues and find the answers around the site.

Hike to Castle Ashby to buy an ice cream.

Put up a lightweight tent with 3 guides blindfolded and one sighted guide giving instructions.

On a paper plate create a campsite using natural objects.

Make a camp oven and cook in it.

Cook popcorn over candle in foil dishes, using a peg for the handle.
