MacQueen House was originally the village school and has been extensively renovated to accommodate 32 people.

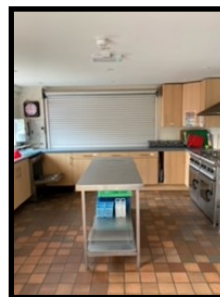
Miss Cecil Wilson Macqueen started Guiding in Northamptonshire in the early 1920s. When she died in 1977 she left Little House, Cranford to Northamptonshire Girl Guide Association to be used as an activity centre. As Little House was unsuitable, when Twywell School closed in 1979 the building was purchased. On the 1 May 1982 the building was reopened as an activity centre and the first Girlguiding residents were the county Rangers.

- Parking is available on hard tarmac enclosed by the site gates. This connects onto the playground.
